

Former State Secretary Rüdiger Hütte

Rüdiger Hütte was born in 1959 in Paderborn, completed military service and went on to study Law in Freiburg im Breisgau, Geneva and Bonn. After completing a legal internship in Düsseldorf, he held various positions in top federal and state agencies in Bonn, Erfurt and Berlin. Most recently, he served as director of the Central Department and deputy head of the Office of the German Federal President. He entered temporary retirement in 2014. After working for a time as an attorney, he became the full-time member of the Executive Board at the German Lost Art Foundation, chiefly responsible for managing the administrative duties of the Foundation.
